Four steps to casting your burdens on God:

Step 1: Say it and say it out loud.

(Psalm 70:1-2; Psalm 69:1-3; Psalm 18: 1-3).

Step 2: Soak in Scripture.

(Psalm 119:105, Romans 15:4, Proverbs 4: 20-23).

Step 3: Sing, Sing, Sing

(Psalm 95: 1-2; Matthew 4:10; John 4:24; Ephesians 5:19-20; Psalm 119:172)

Step 4: Surround yourself with Warriors.

(Hebrews 11:24-25, NIV). (Proverbs 11:14; Proverbs 19:20-21; Proverbs 27:17).
