Assurance of salvation produces a blessed and fruitful life (1 John 5:13-21)

Sanctity of Human Life Sunday is a day designed to remind and challenge each of us to be a part of defending life from conception to natural death. President Ronald Reagan issued a presidential proclamation on January 13, 2918, designating Sunday, January 22, 1984 as National Sanctity of Human Life Day noting that it was the 11th anniversary of Roe v. Wade, in which, the Supreme Court issued a ruling that guaranteed women access to abortion. President Reagan was a strong pro-life advocate who said that in Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court, "Struck down our laws protecting the lives of unborn children. Reagan issued the proclamation annually thereafter, designating Sanctity of Human Life Day to be the closest Sunday to the original January 22 date. *For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. Psalm 139*
