**Sermon Notes**  
**Back to the Basics**

What is the Gospel? What are the Critical Elements?  
**Romans 3:23, 5:8; John 3:16; Romans 6:23, 10:9**

Experience Jesus Christ as your:  
\_\_\_\_\_ (the One who saves you from your sins)  
\_\_\_\_\_ (the One who guides and is in charge of your life).

Such turning away from sin involves a life totally surrendered to Jesus in obedience to His commands.

The gospel we teach determines the disciple we make.

Critical Elements that should always be included when we talk about the gospel:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus is  
He is the Christ  
He is our Savior, Lord, and King
- \_\_\_\_\_ He has done  
He died on the cross and rose from the dead.  
This is the work of salvation —  
what Christ did to save us.
- \_\_\_\_\_ He has done it

He has done this to forgive your sins and bestow on you the benefits that come with salvation.

You can learn more about this if you look at what was written by Paul in 1 Corinthians 15:1-8 and compare it to what was Jesus said in Luke 24:45-49.
