## Why Follow ...

## "The Way of The Cross"?

From the earliest days, followers of Jesus told the story of his passion, death and resurrection. When pilgrims came to see Jerusalem, they were anxious to see the sites where Jesus experienced "The Way of The Cross". These sites became important holy connections with Jesus for those who loved and followed him. Eventually, following in the footsteps of the Lord along "The Way of the Cross", became a part of the pilgrimage visit for those who loved and followed Jesus. The stations, as we know them today, came about when it was no longer easy or even possible to visit the holy sites in Jerusalem. In the 1500's, villages all over Europe started commemorating "The Way of the Cross" using small shrines to remind Christ followers of the places along the route in Jerusalem. Eventually, these shrines became the stations we know and were placed in many churches throughout the world.

We have prepared a simple area where you can follow the footsteps of Jesus as he followed the way of his cross. Through art depicting each station, Scripture readings that reveal what happened at each station, and suggested prayers that may express our thoughts in response to the stations, you have an opportunity to follow "The Way of the Cross" this Lenten season. Our prayer is that this will draw you closer to your Savior as you take time to meditate on what our Lord did for you two-thousand years ago.
